Results Regulation strategies:



Establish siteadapted use !

n (appropriate grazing pressure, timing, grazers). Unwanted plants are either promoted by over- or undergrazing.



Broad-spectrum herbicides create gaps recolonized by weeds again. Often,

selective herbicides are missing.

Avoid disturbances !

Unwanted plants germinate in open soil.

Act early !

The more dominant an unwanted plant has become, the more effort is needed for regulation.

Unwanted plants... are unattractive for livestock low nutrient content thorny, spiny, hairy, woody, bitter or toxic ... outcompete fodder plants ... reduce biodiversity

Conclusion

Sustainable regulation means to be more persistent than the unwanted plant.
