The variety Arara is similarly early heading as the ancient variety Arion. Arara shows a very strong juvenile growth. The variety is very persistent and well adapted to use at higher altitude. It is thus predestinated for the use in marginalities of fodder cropping. With the resistance to rust, Arara shows a strong progress compared to the equally diploid variety Arion.

Breeding material of ART Reckenholz tracing back to Swiss ecotypes as well as material of the variety Aruga.

M0 seed

Row trial 1997 (LP9725) with 22 clone progenies from a polycross in 1995.
