FACILITATE

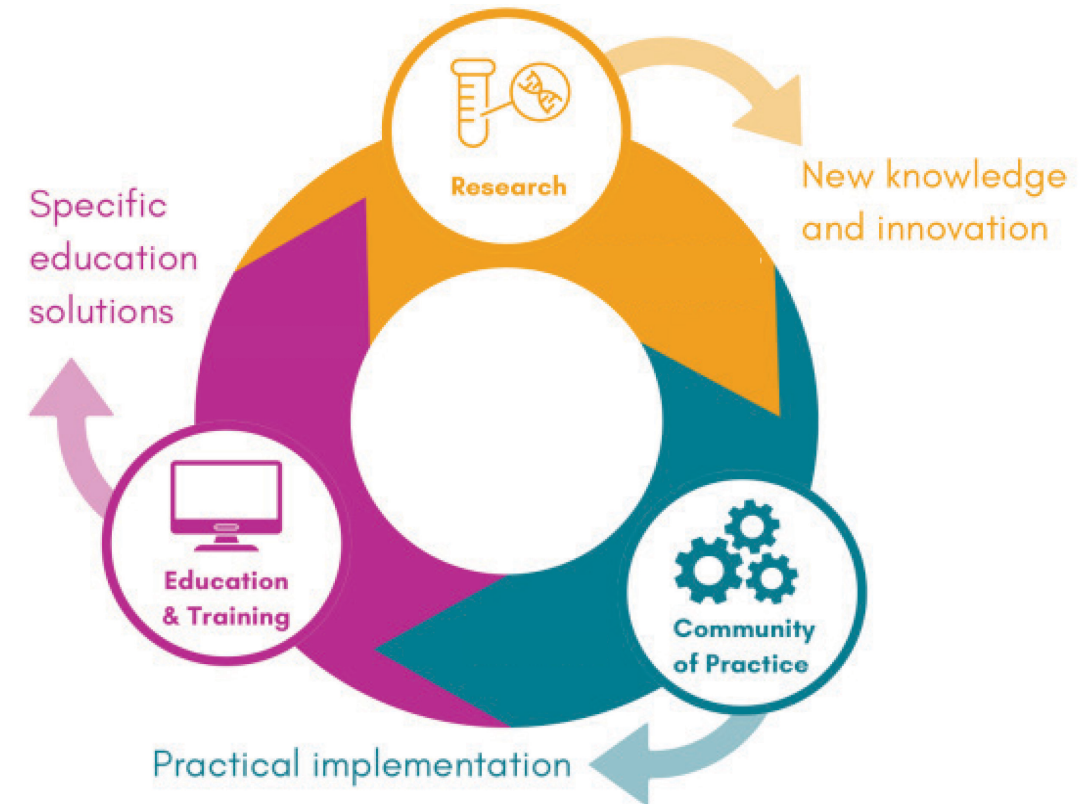
- Implement a Europe-wide **Community of practice (CoP)** with thematic Chapters to promote knowledge transfer

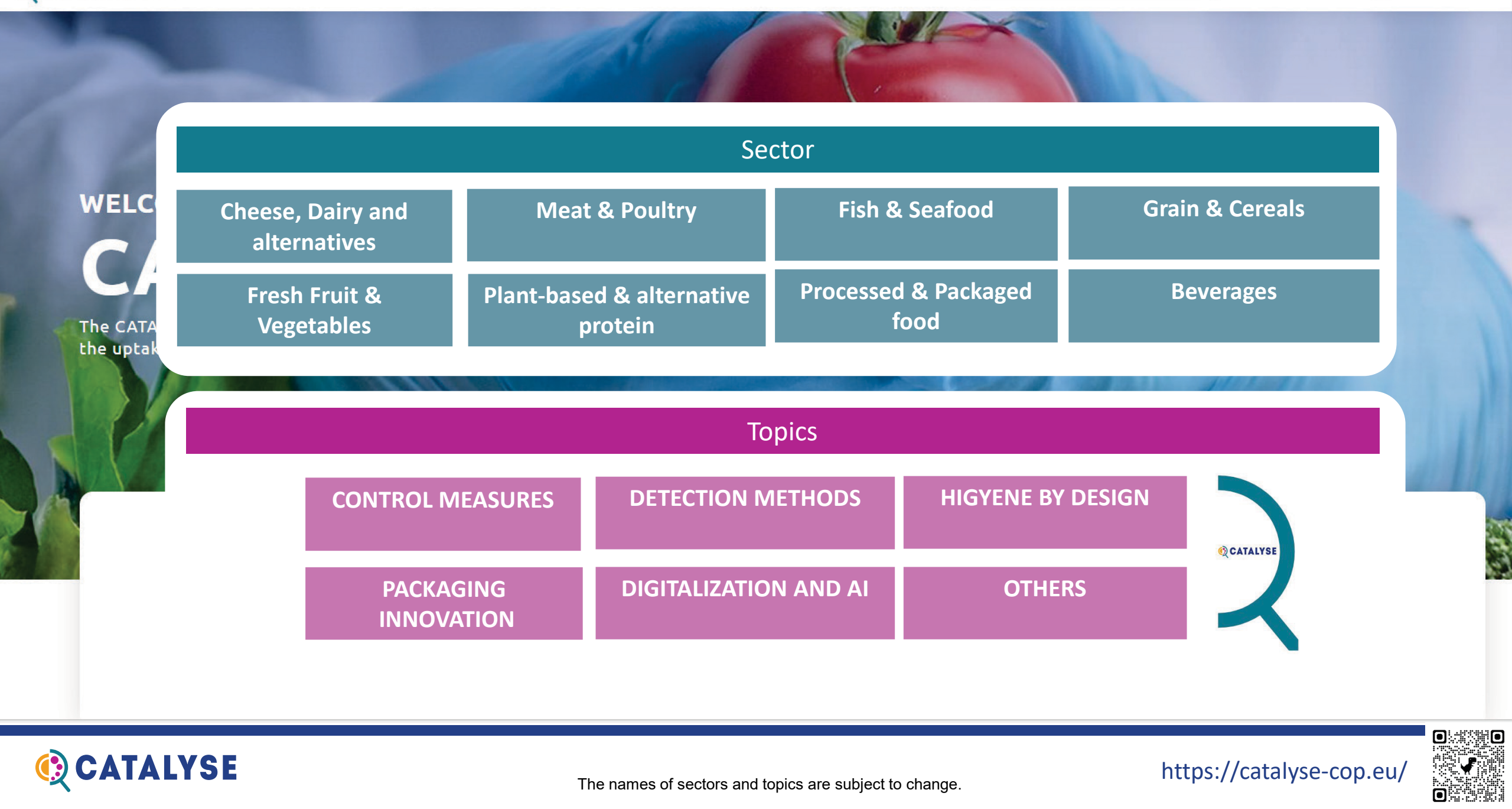
The CATALYSE Community of Practice (CoP) is a forefront platform dedicated to support the food system actors in the uptake of food safety knowledge and innovation.
